

## **Feed Truck Driver/Maintenance**

This person is responsible for:

- Operating the pay loader and feed trucks in a safe manner.
- Delivering precise rations accurately and efficiently.
- Understanding the feed ingredients and proper handling techniques.
- Reporting and recording all feed audits.
- Performing basic preventative maintenance, including replacing bits and changing oils and filters.

Ideal candidate would possess the following qualifications:

- Mechanical interest and aptitude is beneficial.
- Understanding of proper bunk management.
- Commitment to safety and quality culture.
- Ability to use analytical techniques for problem solving, coordination, and decision making.
- Driven, organized, action-oriented, analytical, and ability to multi-task.
- Individual must be team oriented.
- Proven professional communication, presentation, and customer service skills.
- High attention to detail.
- Mechanical interest and aptitude.
- Welding experience, knowledge, and skills.
- Any electrical, hydraulic, and water systems experience.

This position requires:

- Exerting 50-100 pounds of force occasionally; 25-50 pounds of force frequently; 10-20 pounds of force constantly. Standing and sitting frequently; walking, carrying, and lifting/lowering, pushing/pulling, bending, twisting, climbing, crawling, stairs, reaching/handling/grasping, and kneeling/crouching occasionally.
